What a beautiful time of the year to experience Whelan Cemetery, one of the best mesic remnants of Palouse Prairie in the immediate neighborhood! Please join PPF immediately after the grass workshop for a one-hour work party to help eliminate broad leaf weeds at this site. Whelan Cemetery is about a mile as the crow flies from the Folwell home. Bring gloves and a hand weeding tool or knife to wage war on mullein, mustards, tragopogon, and other easily-dispatched invasives.
